Where do we meet?



PCC maintains an Astroturf runway and support facilities at a field in Half Moon Bay. The PCC airfield is approximately 3.7 miles south of Highway 92 on the east side of Highway 1 in Half Moon Bay. For driving instructions and a map, go to

You may fly as a guest if, and only if, there is a PCC member present, and you have current AMA membership. Be sure to get a field orientation from a club member before flying, as we have specific flying areas and “no-fly” zones. You will be asked to show your AMA card.
